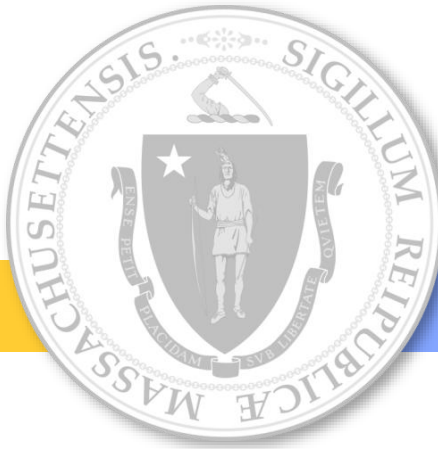

3.6 Enhancement Summary

Profile Tab

Informed consent date will not accept values prior to 1/1/23

Transition Tab

- 'Is member eligible for MassHealth' question has been disabled
- Qualifying information section has new questions
 - Is member transitioning to Non-Qualified Residence? (Yes/No)
 - If 'No', select 'Type of Non-Qualified Residence' member transitioned to
 - Enrollee End Date

3.6 Enhancement Summary - continued



Events Tab

- New status – Suspended Incomplete (IC) meaning that risk assessment and/or back up plan dates are missing
- Individuals who had a 'Suspended followed by death' status will now be listed as 'Disenrolled' with reason as 'Death'
- Individuals who have been Suspended for more than 90 days will no longer have a Disenrolled status but now will have a status of 'Suspended 91 or more days'
- Added 'Withdrawal' in Participant Event reason dropdown
- Added 'Please Explain' text box for Disenrollment Reason 'Other'



3.7 Enhancement Summary

- Updated Social Security Number logic that allows for numbers that begin with 800s
- New required questions on the **Transition Tab** for any discharges on or after 12/21/2025:
 - Housing Type section– questions about housing vouchers and subsidized housing units
 - Community Living Initiative section – one question about the type of community setting
 - Transition residence – questions about if housing search assistance was provided and if the individual transitioned to a new or existing home



MFP-IS Transition Tab – Qualifying Information

- 'Is member eligible for Massachusetts Medicaid?' has been disabled. This information is only verified by MassHealth.
- Is the length of stay greater than or equal to 60 days? This is the discharge date minus the admission date.

MFP-IS Transition Tab – Qualifying Information

Has member transition to a Qualified Residence (as defined by the MFP Demo)? If no, then the type of Non-Qualified Residence must be selected:

- Assisted Living Residence
- Group Home of 5 or more
- Hotel or Motel
- Other (if chosen, 'Please Explain' is required)
- Rest Home
- Rooming House or Boarding House
- Shelter

Note: The Enrollee End Date is the transition date.

MFP-IS Transition Tab – Housing Vouchers

Housing Vouchers	Definition
811 Vouchers	Federally funded portable vouchers for people with disabilities aged 18-62
Alternative Housing Voucher Program (AHVP)	State voucher program offering rental assistance for people with a disability who are under age 60
DMH Rental Subsidy	State funded rental voucher program for DMH clients
MA Rental Voucher Program (MRVP)	State voucher program offering rental assistance in the form of vouchers to low-income families and individuals
Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers	Federally funded rental voucher program for people with low incomes. Some vouchers are set aside for people with disabilities

MFP-IS Transition Tab – Housing Type Section

Subsidized Housing Units	Definition
3% Priority Housing	Priority access to community-based housing units coupled with access to services for people with disabilities and older adults (specific for consumers receiving services from DMH, DDS, MassAbility, and AGE)
Community Based Housing	Integrated housing units for people with disabilities, including older adults, with priority for individuals who are in institutions, nursing facilities or at risk of institutionalization
DMH DDS Set Aside	Priority access to community-based housing units coupled with access to services for people with disabilities and older adults (specific for consumers receiving services from DMH or DDS)
Facilities Consolidation Fund	Community-based housing units for clients of DMH or DDS
Public housing unit	Decent and safe rental housing units operated by local housing authorities (state or federal) for eligible low-income families, older adults, and persons with disabilities (e.g., Boston Housing Authority unit)
Section 811 PRA	Affordable integrated housing units for individuals with disabilities who are aged 18-61



What is the Community Living Initiative?

Through this initiative Massachusetts will assist a minimum of 2,400 MassHealth eligible individuals to transition from nursing facilities to the community over 8 years.

The transition data is being captured by AGE, DDS, DMH, MBY, and the MFP Demo.

The housing voucher, subsidy, and the community living initiative questions in MFP-IS are all asked on the CTLP Supported NF Transition Assessment as well.
